We had a busy week working in jolly phonics. We did the formation of the sound 'f' and recognized the sound in different pictures.

Activities Covered:

Last week we started a two-week series topic on Community Helpers and focused on emergency field helpers such as the police, doctors, dentists, firemen, and paramedics. We also learnt the emergency number of Qatar, which is 999.

In **Communication and Language**, we listened to emergency sounds such as ambulance sirens, fire drills, and police sirens. We also discussed the differences between Qatar's Civil Defence and those outside Qatar. We found out that the colours of the uniform and the fire truck are different from other countries.

In **Physical Development**, we roleplayed being police officers. We had fun chasing each other like real police officers.

In **Personal, Social, and Emotional Development** we continued practicing for the school concert. We are getting used to the new routine and learning our parts very well.

In **Literacy**, we learnt the jolly phonics sound 'f' as in flower. We learned its action, and song, and then practiced its formation in different mediums and our workbooks. Then we made a flower craft to help us remember the sound.

In **Mathematics**, we continued to sequence events & describe familiar routes. We also took part in various hands-on activities. Furthermore, we learned the crescent shape.

On Thursday, we came to school dressed up to celebrate career day. We represented different types of professions with the outfits that we wore. Throughout the day, we rotated classes to explore more places of work and engaged in various activities. We went to a bakery, a hair salon, a hospital, and a supermarket.

It was exciting to know more about these places of work.



The Math activities were so exciting. We had to think about how to make a sandwich and sequenced each step.

Upcoming Activities:

This week we will continue to learn about Community Helpers. As we learn more about these important people the more, we want to grow up and be just like one of them. We will focus on non-emergency community helpers such as chefs, hairdressers, builders, teachers, etc.

In **Communication and Language**, we will learn about the role of a chef and will discuss how they work in the kitchen and prepare different food delicious for us.

In **Mathematics**, we will continue working on sequencing events & describing familiar routes through various hands-on tasks. We will also learn about the semi-circle and pentagon shapes.

In **Literacy**, we will learn the final sound in the Jolly Phonics program for preschool, the sound 'b'.

In **Physical Development**, we will discuss the job of a hairdresser. We will further develop our fine motor skills by cutting different lines and yarn to make hair.
