Activities Covered:

Last week, we continued to explore our Transportation theme and This week is going to be a week of revision for Literacy and food delivery. We also learnt about the different transportation school concert. services we use such as the school bus and taxis.

In Communication and Language, we listened to the story 'Cars and Trucks and Things That Go' where we uncovered how different goods are transported in different transportation based on their type and sizes. We also looked at how we get our food and goods into Qatar.

In Personal, social, and Emotional Development we curated a small world of transportation so we could transport different goods around the classroom.

In Physical Development, we listened to the story 'Goodnight, Goodnight, Construction Site'. Then we participated in an interesting yoga activity based on construction vehicles.

In Mathematics, we revised counting in 2s and 5s. Then we counted in 10s to 100 using various hands-on manipulatives.

In Literacy, we revised the sounds ai, oa, ie, ee, or, ng. We wrote words with each sound and wrote sentences with capital letters and full stops. We were also assessed for the term 3 progress report.
