Activities Covered:

Last week, we continued the topic of **Transportation**. We focused on the **transportation of goods and services** from one point to another. For example, how vegetables from the farm arrive at the supermarket and how goods from the supermarket get to our homes.

In **Communication and Language**, we read the story '**Tremendous Tractors**' and learnt how a tractor is used to transport goods across the farm and other places. Then we made a tractor craft.

In **Physical Development**, we read the story '**The Little School Bus**' and discussed the service it provides to families so the children can arrive at school and home safely. We also got to make a yellow school bus craft using our fine motor skills paint, cut, and stick the resources we needed.

In **Literacy**, we revised the learnt sounds /s/a/t/i/p/n/c/k/e/h/r/m/d/g/o/u/l/b/ and we worked to find the initial sounds in different pictures. We also focussed on our end-of-the-term assessment.

In **Mathematics** we learnt a new concept of sharing items to make two groups of the same amount. We practiced this through various hands-on activities.

Last Tuesday, we had a preview of how our school concert and graduation ceremony will look like through a whole school rehearsal. We are surely going to put on a great performance for our parents and family.

We are getting excited to perform on the big day!

Upcoming Activities:

This week is going to be a week of revision for Literacy and Mathematics. It will also be a week of the countdown to the school concert.

In **Mathematics**, we will revise counting to 20 and we will continue working on how to make two groups the same by taking part in various hands-on activities.

In **Literacy**, we will revise all the learned sounds /s/a/t/i/p/n/c/k/e/h/r/m/d/g/o/u/l/b/ and we will continue to blend them to read 2-letter words.

On Wednesday, we will be going for a dress rehearsal at the Qatar National Convention Centre (QNCC). This will help us get familiarised with the stage.
