We learnt about planets and performed the bubbling planet experiment using baking soda, vinegar and food coloring.

We discussed how fast a rocket can go up in the sky and made our own rocket using plastic bottles.

Activities Covered:

Last week, we travelled through Space!! We learnt so many fun facts about outer space and the solar system. We learnt about planets, stars, and astronauts. We've had lots of fun activities, including making our own rockets and dressing up as space explorers.

In Communication and Language, we listened to the story 'The Solar System' to learn all about the features of space. Then we created our very own space artwork.

In Personal, Social, and Emotional development, we listened to the story 'Back to the Earth with a Bump' and discussed the feelings and emotions of the astronaut in the story. We later coloured our astronaut picture and added it to the space artwork we made.

In Literacy, we revised the learnt sounds /s/a/t/i/p/n/c/k/e/h/r/m/d/g/o/u/l/b/ and we worked to find the initial sounds in different pictures. We also focussed on blending 2 and 3 sounds to read new words.

In **Mathematics**, we learnt a new concept of separating groups of 2 up to 20 objects in different ways using the vocabulary 'less, more, and equal. We practiced this through various handson activities.

On Thursday, we beat the heat with a fun water play activity. We came to school in our swimming costumes and had fun with our friends and teachers. We also enjoyed an ice lolly to keep us cool
