Activities Covered:

Last week we covered an exciting topic, **space**! It was interesting to learn about the solar system and how an astronaut goes to space.

In Communication and Language, we listened to the story 'If I were an Astronaut'. We discussed the story, and we completed our own space shuttle craft.

In Personal, Social and Emotional Development, we worked as a team to construct spacecrafts using recycling materials. We displayed resilience in this challenge.

In **Physical Development**, we tried to follow the sequence in a space dance. It was so much fun!

In **Literacy**, we revised the *qu*, *ou*, *oi*, *ue*, *er*, *ar* sounds. We wrote words with these sounds and use some of these words in sentences. We also reviewed all the high frequency words learnt this year.

In Mathematics, we did revision on the concepts of addition and subtraction. We used concrete objects to solve various number problems.

In **Understanding the World**, we learnt about the solar system and guess what, there are a sun, moon, eight planets and millions of stars. We created a fun glass window space display.

In Expressive Arts and Design, we created small space world with different types of materials.

On Thursday, we beat the heat with a fun water play activity. We came to school in our swimming costumes and had fun with our friends and teachers.

This week is a **fun week**. What a fitting topic to end our year! We will participate in lots of fun activities to make our last week a memorable one.
