Last week, we began the topic of growing a healthy environment.

In Communication and Language, we will learn about what it means to have a healthy environment through the story 'The Lorax'. We learnt new vocabulary and recalled parts of the story in our own words.

In Physical Development, we teamed up in pairs and went on a nature scavenger hunt in the schoolyard to look for natural things in the environment. We found some in their natural state, some on the painted walls and some were artificial.

In Literacy, we learnt the High-Frequency words 'to' and 'and'. We continued to build sentences using these words. We also learnt the Jolly Phonics sounds u and 1. We practiced recognising these sounds in words, correct formation in various mediums and made crafts to help us remember them.

In Understanding the World, we focused on ocean pollution and how it negatively affects the marine environment. We then completed an interesting oil spill experiment to demonstrate how the sea gets polluted and how difficult it is to clean it up. This was eye-opening.

In Expressive Arts and Design, we got busy creating a masterpiece from recyclable items such as cardboard boxes, empty water bottles, and more.

On Thursday, we came to school with a recycling project we made from home. We talked to our friends about it and what types of materials we reused to make our project. We also participated in various games using only recyclable materials once more. We are developing our knowledge of keeping our environment clean and safe for all to use.
