Activities Covered:

Last week, in week 10 we learned all about 'Growing a Healthy Environment' and focused on how to be active citizens in taking care of our environment. We play an important role in making sure our planet stays healthy and clean.

In **Communication and Language**, we listened to and discussed the story "Love Our Earth". This story helped enhance our knowledge of preserving our environment. Then we made a planet earth craft.

In **Personal, Social, and Emotional Development**, we listened to the story "Look out for Litter" which explained why we should not litter. After the story, we role-played a game about littering and what we should do if we see someone littering.

In **Literacy**, we learned the Jolly Phonics sounds **c** and **k**. We continued to practice recognising these sounds in our environment, correct formation in various mediums and made crafts to help us remember these new sounds.

In **Mathematics**, we completed our math assessments, and we are so proud of our children for their confidence and understanding of the work we have covered so far.

In **Understanding the World**, we focused on water pollution and how it negatively affects the environment. We completed an interesting activity of cleaning up the dirty animals in makeshift polluted water.

On Thursday we showcased all the beautiful arts and crafts we created using the recycled materials we have collected over the weeks. It is a great idea to limit the amount of waste we produce by using our imaginations to make interesting installations for school or home.

We had a very interesting week of fun and learning!

Upcoming Activities:

Coming up in week 11, we will continue the theme 'Growing-Health Environment' and focus on how we can differentiate between the materials we are recycling and guiding those around us to make better choices for our planet. Together we can make a difference.

In **Communication and Language**, we will follow along in the story 'Keeping our Surroundings Clean' and learn that it is important to have fun but just as important to be mindful of how our habits affect our environment.

In **Personal, Social, and Emotional Development**, we will play a recycling sorting game. In this game, we will learn the difference between the materials of things we can recycle and the damage they cause to the environment if we don't recycle them.

In **Understanding the World**, we will watch a beautiful story created and produced by young creators here in Qatar about 'HOPE'.

It is going to be an important week guiding us to a better understanding of the world around us.
