Activities Covered:

Last week, we visited 2 different countries: **China** and **Mexico**. We learned many things about the cultures and traditions of those countries and where they are in the world.

On **Sunday**, we worked on a PowerPoint about each country and learned about the different languages, famous landmarks, food, traditional clothes, and currency.

On Monday, we listened to a traditional folk tale from China called 'The Empty Pot' and from Mexico, we listened to the stories 'Pollito Tito (Chicken Little)' and 'El Pájaro y la Ballena (The Bird and the Whale)'. After that, we travelled with our passports around the school to get them stamped from all the different countries participating in the international week. We also decorated the flags of **China** and **Mexico**.

On **Thursday**, we came to school dressed in our own country's attire or flag colours and enjoyed an international feast of foods unique to our own country. We also played different traditional games from **China** and **Mexico**. Some were familiar and some were new to learn.

We learned that we don't have to travel only to relax but we can enjoy and learn more about the countries culture, foods, and historical values to help us understand and appreciate our similarities as well as our differences.
