In literacy, we learnt the letter formation and the sound of 'oa' and 'ie'. We can blend but with a little more practice we will be super readers.

## Activities Covered:

Last week, we stayed on the farm and learnt all about **Farm animals' produce** and other produce. We discovered the different types of products we can get from farm animals, we also learnt that all fruits and vegetables come from all over the world.

In **Communication and Language**, we listened to the story "**The Little Red Hen**". We were able to retell the story with actions as we learnt the whole process from planting the grains to baking bread with flour. In **Literacy**, we learnt 2 new jolly phonics sounds **oa** & **ie**. We learnt their actions, songs, and formation before practicing them in our books. The High-Frequency words for this week are **at** & **go**. It was really funny listening to all the silly sentences we came up with.

In **Mathematics**, we learnt 3D shapes, sphere, cube, cone, and triangular prism. We used fun hands-on activities to learn these shapes. Making the shapes using wood sticks and air-dry clay was super fun! These shapes are all around us, all we have to do is look closely.

In **Understanding of the World**, we learnt how to milk a cow. We didn't get it at first, but it got easier as we practiced more and more. And we even made butter! Can you believe it! We made butter. That was really fun, great fun!

On Thursday, we had a visit from the veterinarian, and they showed us how to properly take care of our pets and make sure that they feel the same just as we are happy, safe, loved, and healthy. Some of our friends brought their pets from home to show and describe how they look after them at home.

## Upcoming Activities:

For **Mathematics**, we will introduce the 3D shapes, cylinder, pyramid, and rectangular prism(cuboid). We will continue using fun hands-on activities to learn these shapes.
